

SING TO ME OF HEAVEN. S.M.

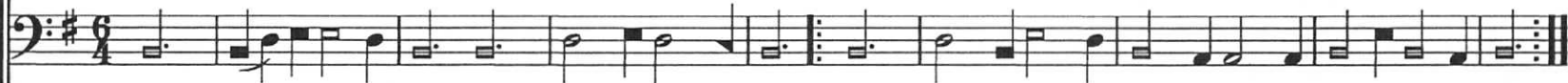
"I will sing with the Spirit." -- 1 Cor. 14:15.
